REAL CONSERVATIVES LIKE CONTINGENCY FEES

Conservatives like the American Enterprise Institute say:

- Contingent fees improve access to the courts for low-income plaintiffs.
- Contingent fees help to spread risk since the plaintiff does not pay if he loses the case.
- Rather than encourage baseless lawsuits, the contingent fee actually helps screen them out of the system.
- Contingent fees do not increase awards.
