A GROWING NUMBER OF RICH COMPANIES ARE FORCING CONSUMERS TO ARBITRATE DISPUTES

At least 81 companies in the Fortune 100 use forced arbitration clauses in consumer contracts.

78 also ban class actions.



When a case is thrown out of court and into private arbitration because of one of these clauses, the claims usually disappear and wrongdoers escape accountability.
