## FIVE FACTS ABOUT TAKATA AIRBAGS



- Takata's exploding, shrapnel-spraying airbags are the subject of the biggest U.S. consumer product recall in history.
- Takata's U.S. recall covers 33.8 million vehicles, including at least 15 vehicle brands and 60 models; worldwide, over 50 million vehicles have defective airbags.
- Takata is currently making only 500,000 replacement airbags per month<sup>4</sup>; U.S. repairs could take at least 5 years.
- It is estimated that 25 to 30 percent of U.S. cars with defective airbags – or about 10 million cars - will never be repaired.
- To date, at least 6 deaths and 64 injuries have been linked to exploding Takata airbags.
