



THE ABC'S OF "TORT REFORM" FAILS

"Tort reform" does not

- (a). attract physicians to a particular location
- (b). reduce "defensive medicine" (unnecessary tests or procedures to avoid liability risk)
- (c). reduce health care costs.

INSTEAD, "TORT REFORM" LIKELY INCREASES COSTS.
