While most of the industrialized world has banned asbestos, the United States has not, prohibiting it only in a limited number of products.



Asbestos is allowed in vinyl floor tiles, cement pipes and car parts like automatic transmission components, clutch facings, friction materials, disk brake pads, drum brake linings, brake blocks and gaskets.



As a result, thousands still die each year of asbestos disease including younger and younger victims.
