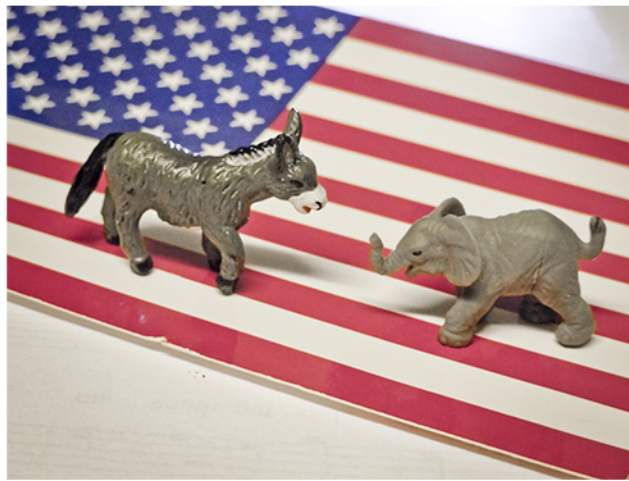




# Spotlight On Justice
